

"IL VINRÉ" SAUVIGNON LANGHE BIANCO DOC

Name: "Il Vinré" Sauvignon Langhe Bianco doc

Appellation: Denominazione di Origine Controllata

Area of Origin: Sauvignon, grape of French origin, is well cultivated in many parts of Italy. The "Vinré" Sauvignon is grown in the vineyards of the Talloria Valley, close to Giordano wine cellars.

Hints of the Vineyard: This wine is produced from the beautiful vineyards of the Talloria Valley, close to Giordano Wines cellars.

Vinification: The grapes are softly pressed and fermented at controlled temperature.

Grape Variety: Sauvignon Blanc

Tasting Notes: Straw yellow in colour, Vinré has an intense aroma with hints of sage and wildflowers, dry and fruity flavour, softened by the refining in bottle. A wine that combines fresh scents, typical of Sauvignon, with the structure, flavour complexity and longevity of the Langhe's best whites.

Food Pairing Notes: Excellent as an aperitif, it expresses all its bouquet and its pleasant and fresh taste with fish dishes at best, especially with fresh shellfish and seafood.
